

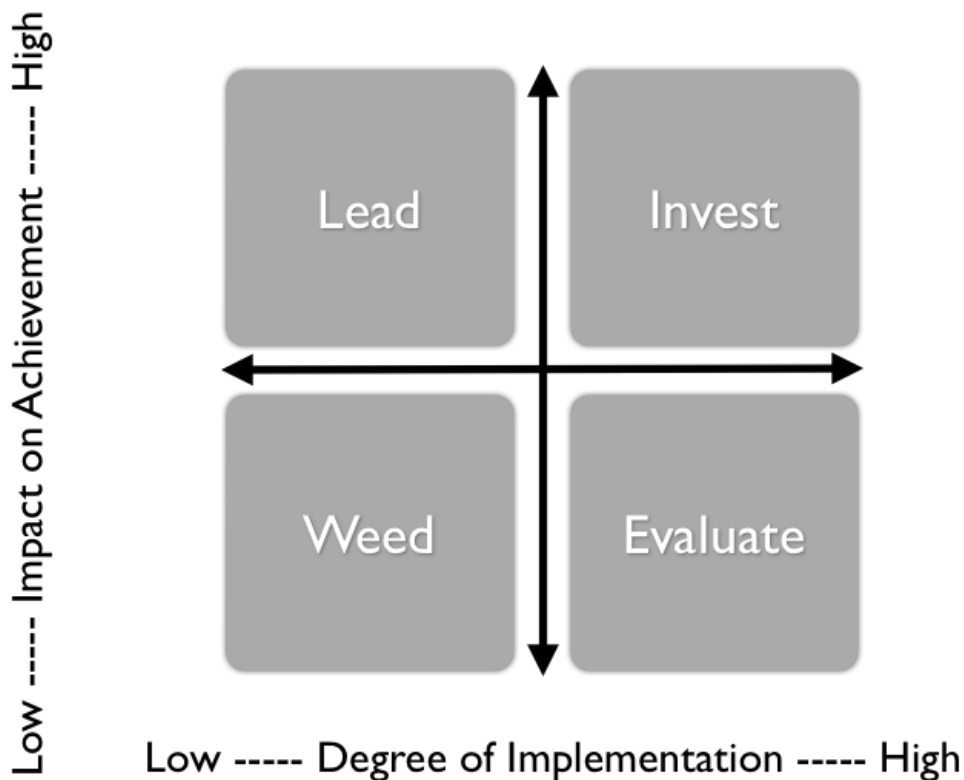
Weed the Garden!
